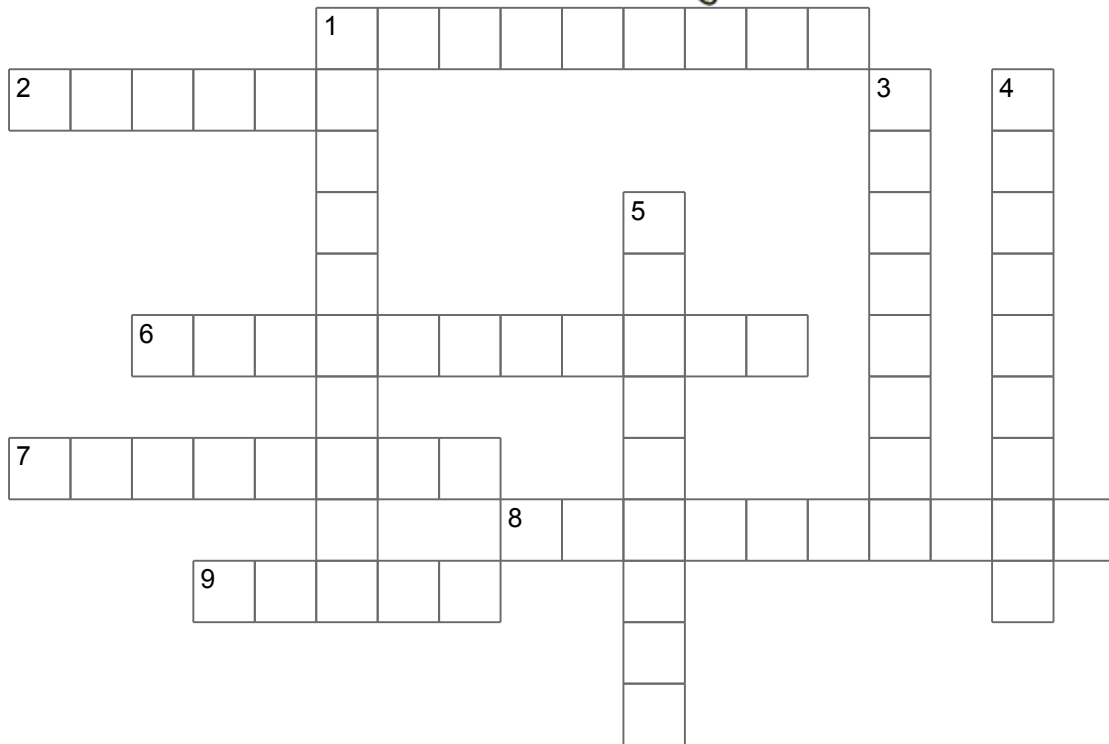

## ACROSS

1. A bunt that allows a baserunner to move to the next base while the batter gets out
2. Either of two low shelters on either side of a baseball diamond where the players and coaches sit during the game
6. A play in which a runner on third base tries to score as the batter bunts the pitch
7. A putout of a base runner who is required to run and cannot make the next base safely
8. The act of getting three players out on one play
9. A baserunner's successful advance from one base to the next on his own

## DOWN

1. The area over home plate between a batter's knees and shoulders through which a pitch must pass in order to be called a strike
3. A baseball thrown with little velocity when the batter is expecting a fastball
4. A home run with the bases loaded, scoring four runs
5. An errant pitch that the catcher cannot be expected to catch and that allows a base runner to advance a base
