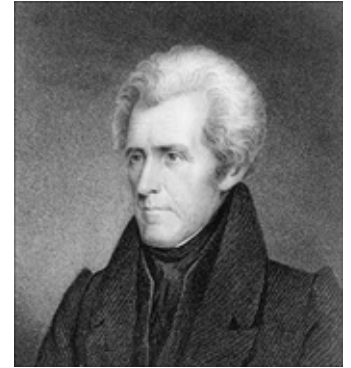

1. Andrew Jackson 7th President of the United States
2. Rachel Donelson Jackson First Lady, died a month before Jackson took office
3. John C. Calhoun Vice President to Andrew Jackson during his 1st term; supported nullification, resigned vice-presidency
4. Martin Van Buren Vice President to Andrew Jackson during his 2nd term; succeeded Jackson as president
5. Democratic Andrew Jackson's political party
6. Waxhaw, South Carolina Andrew Jackson's birthplace, born on March 15, 1767
7. Old Hickory Nickname earned for his toughness, like the hard wood of the hickory tree
8. Peggy Eaton Affair Scandal involving Jackson's cabinet and their wives
9. Indian Removal Act Forced Native Americans to leave their homes and move west
10. Nullification Crisis Involved Calhoun's belief that a state can refuse to obey a federal law if not in the best interest of the state
11. Spoils system Employing and promoting friends and supporters of the group in power
