Camp Fire Girls was founded on March 17, 1910, by Dr. Luther Gulick and his wife, Charlotte Gulick. “Camp Fire” was chosen as the name because campfires were the origin of the first communities and domestic life. The first meetings were held in Vermont in 1910. In 1975, Camp Fire USA expanded to include boys in the program. To this day, Camp Fire USA is one of the nation’s leading youth development organizations serving thousands of children and youth each year.
