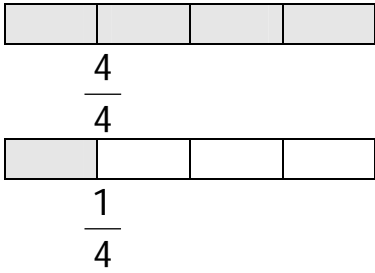


Change the Improper Fractions to Mixed Numbers



An improper fraction occurs when the numerator is larger than the denominator. $\frac{5}{4}$ This fraction is actually larger than 1 whole.

Therefore, when we change it to a mixed number, we have $1 \frac{1}{4}$

Change the following improper fractions to mixed numbers. The first one is done for you

Step 1: How many times does the numerator 3 divide into the denominator 8? This number becomes the whole number (2)

$\frac{8}{3}$ **Step 2:** $8 \div 3 = 2$ with a remainder of 2. The remainder becomes the numerator.

Step 3: Now write the Mixed number! $2 \frac{2}{3}$ The denominator remains the same.

$\frac{9}{3} =$	$\frac{4}{3} =$
$\frac{21}{8} =$	$\frac{9}{5} =$
$\frac{12}{3} =$	$\frac{9}{2} =$
$\frac{10}{4} =$	$\frac{16}{7} =$
$\frac{14}{3} =$	$\frac{9}{3} =$
